

# 2025 NSCCI National Competition

## **Purpose**

 To promote innovative, interdisciplinary patient-oriented research related to the broad area of Complex Care in Child Health.

### **Criteria**

Applications must be focused on children with medical complexity (CMC). CMC are defined as those children with:

- One or more complex chronic conditions (often multisystem and severe),
- Significant functional limitation often causing reliance on technology e.g., feeding tubes and tracheostomies,
- High healthcare utilization, requiring specialized care/services from a variety of providers across multiple sectors,
- High healthcare service needs e.g., care provision in the home and care coordination.

Applications that relate to specific patient populations that have a primary underlying diagnosis with firmly established advocacy and support groups and access to other funding sources (e.g., childhood cancer, cystic fibrosis, transplant patients) will <u>not</u> be considered eligible for this competition.

#### **Eligibility**

- Physicians, nurses, allied health professionals, researchers and trainees who are affiliated with an academic health science centre or university in Canada.
- New and early career investigators are encouraged to apply.
- Research partnership with patients and families, community groups, and/or family advisors is strongly
  recommended, and applications should include a patient and family engagement plan (including a budget where
  appropriate).

#### Amount of Award

Approximately \$60,000 is available this year for all grants. We will allow a maximum budget of up to \$60,000.00 for each application, however we highly recommend budgeting up to \$30,000.00 to maximize the number of grants we can award. If more funds are essential for completion of the project, this will need to be justified.

Deadline:September 30, 2025Decisions:Award recipients are expected to be notified by approximately mid December 2025
